What Ails Engineering: Made in India to Make Abroad ?

It is often lamented that Engineers are the most unemployed category of professionals in India. Multi-National Companies(MNCs) who absorb many competent engineers other than those in the core fields like the Civil, Mechanical, Electrical and Petrochemical do so more for their computing skills, soft skills and above all, their communication skills.
