#### SAFETY

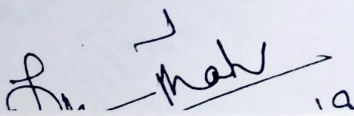
8.1 EXCEL Engineering College shall take all the necessary and other safety precautions to protect their students / faculty during the industrial training & industrial visits.

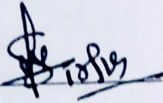

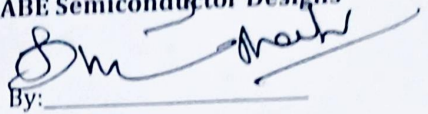
