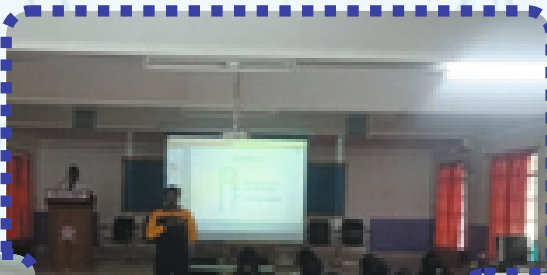
ERODE MARATHON

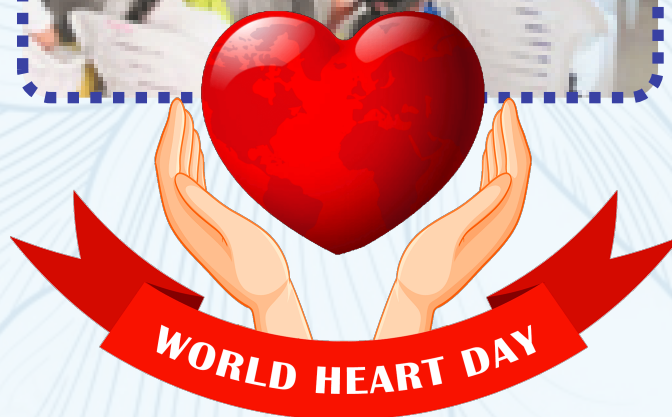
WORLD SUICIDE PREVENTION DAY

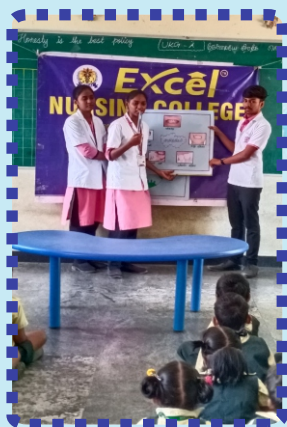


National Nutrition Week

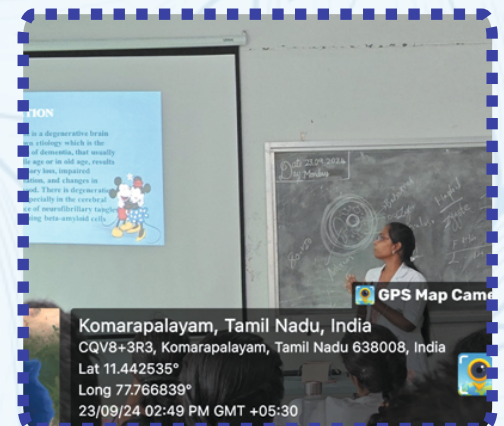
World Rose Day seminar
