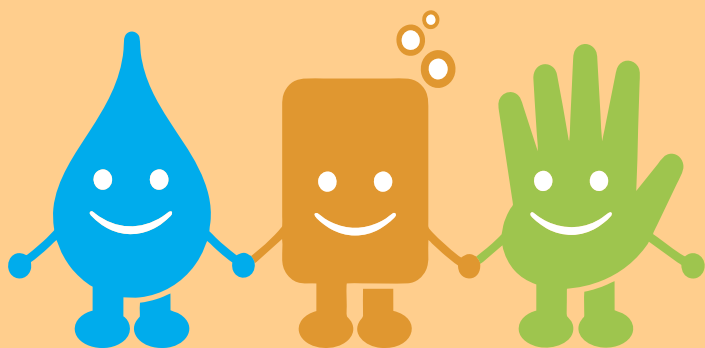

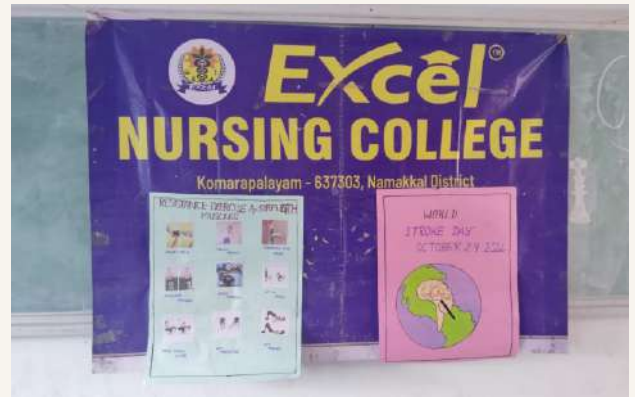

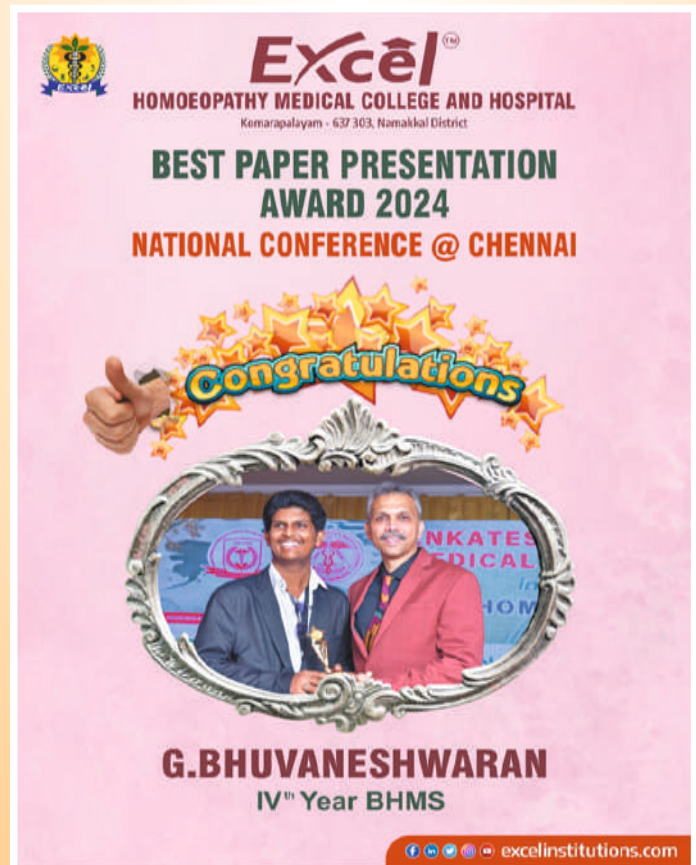

FIRELESS COOKING *Competition* 19.10.2024

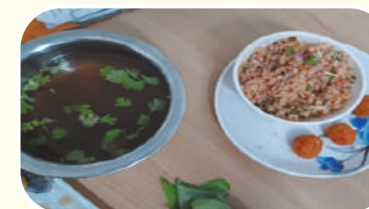
Our Excel Siddha Medical College & Research Centre conducted Fireless Cooking Competition on 19.10.2024.

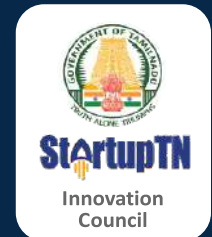
The objective of the competition is to prepare and present a variety of dishes without using fire. The participants are required to use alternative methods to fireless cooking methods.
