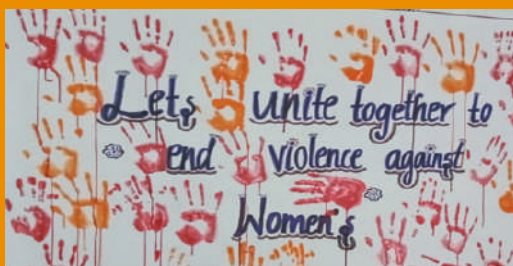
# WORLD DIABETES DAY

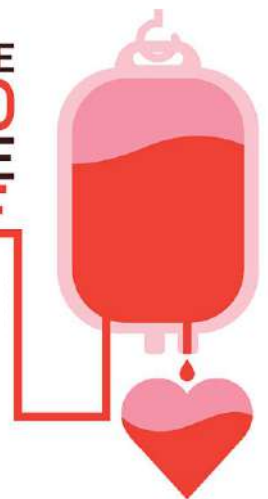

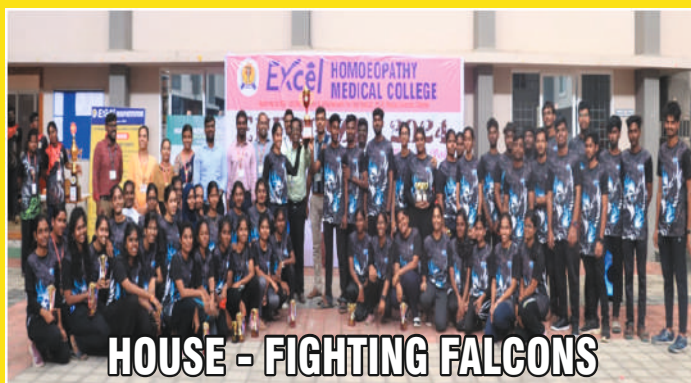

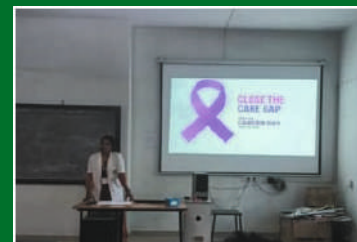
