Our Teaching Faculties, Medical Officers, Students are participated in this programme.







On observance of no smoking day, our excel siddha medical college and research centre, conducted a seminar to provide deep insight about no smoking and its importance.

Our Final year Student Mr.S.Karthikeyan delivered a seminar on the topic "World TB day".


