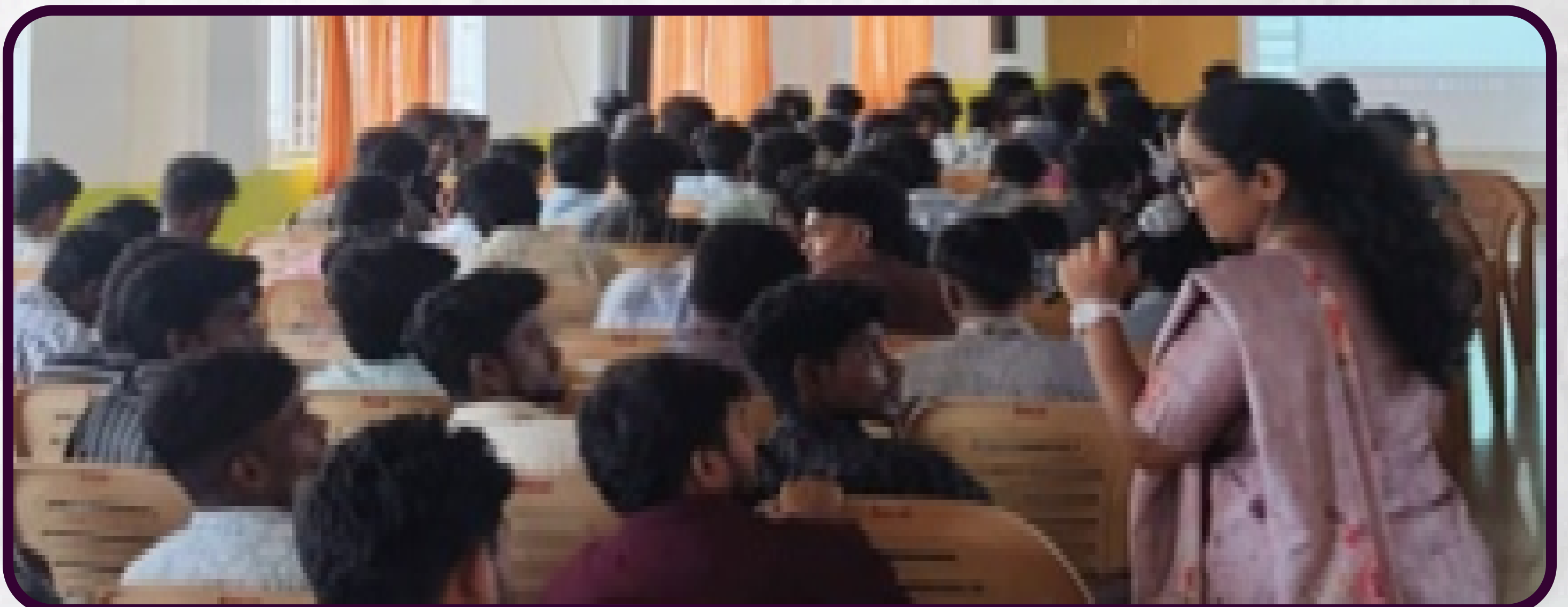


REDISCOVERING INDIAN INTELLECTUAL MERITAGE: VEDIC MATHEMATICS BY DR. RAMANUJAM

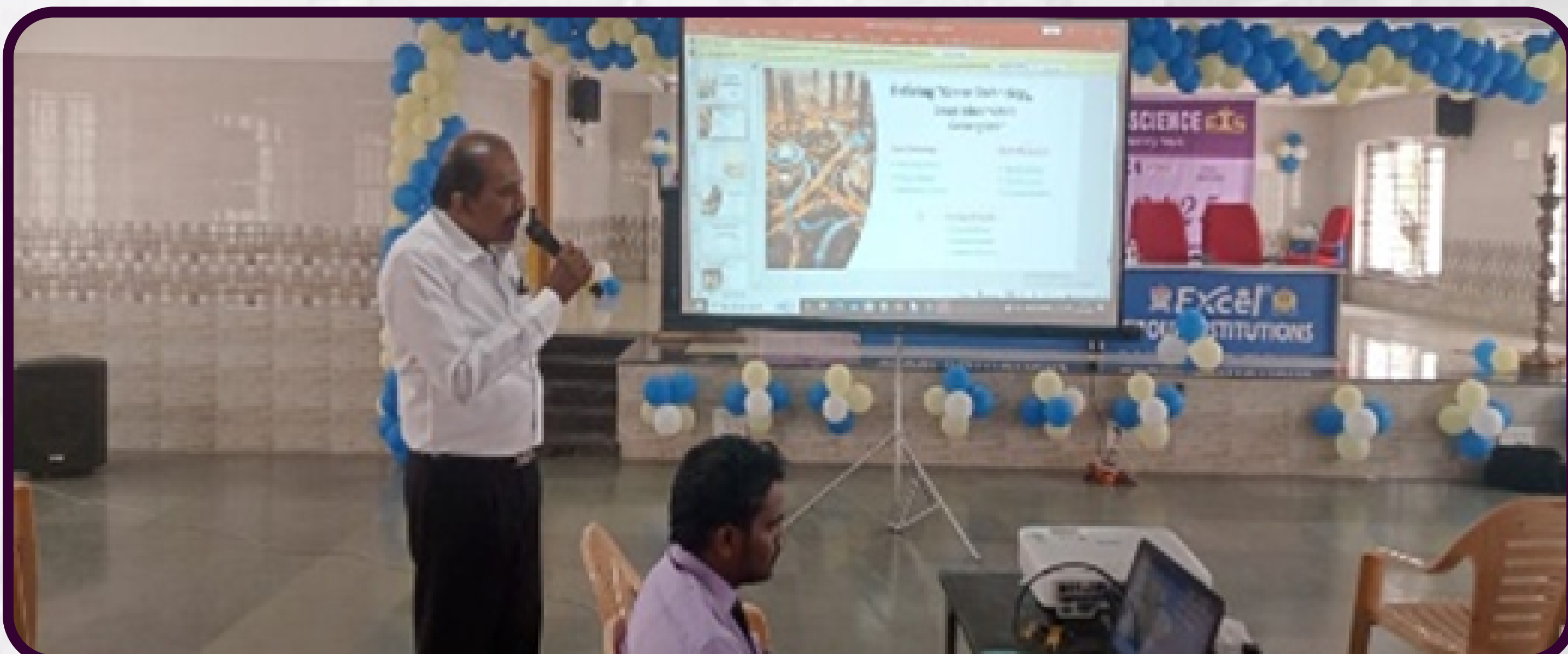


INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE 2025

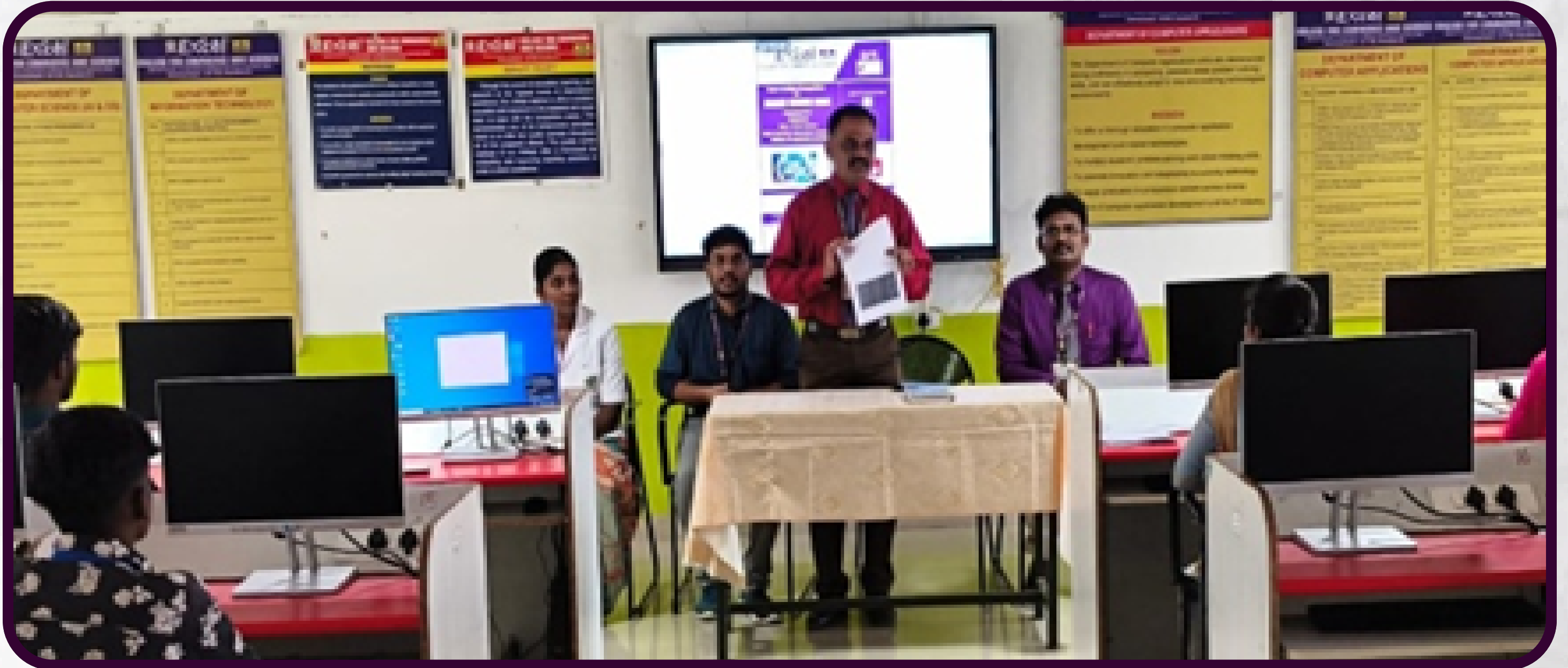
