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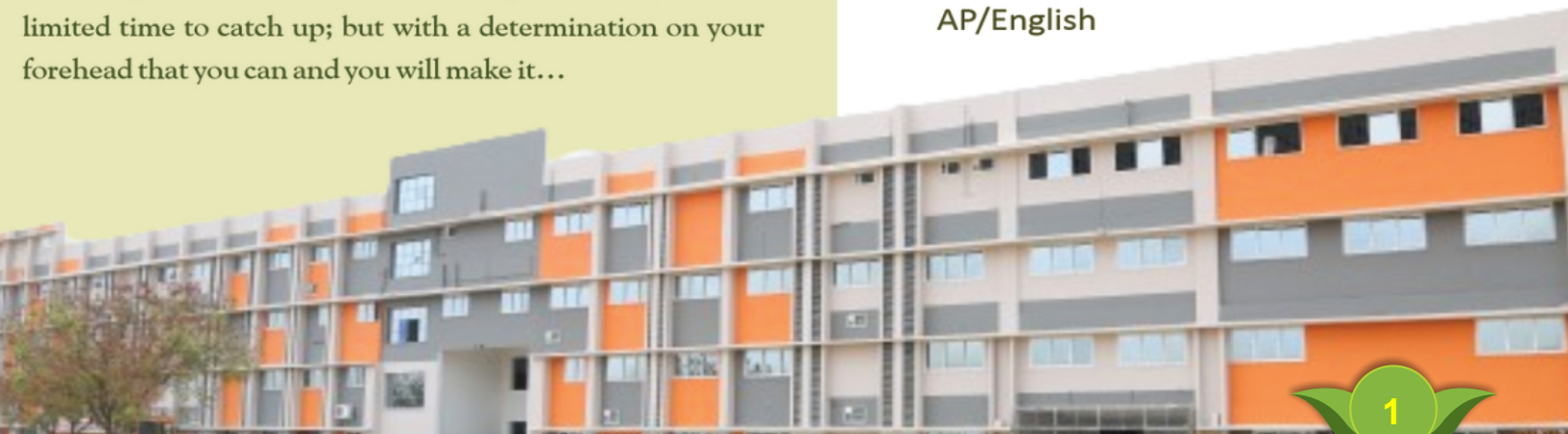

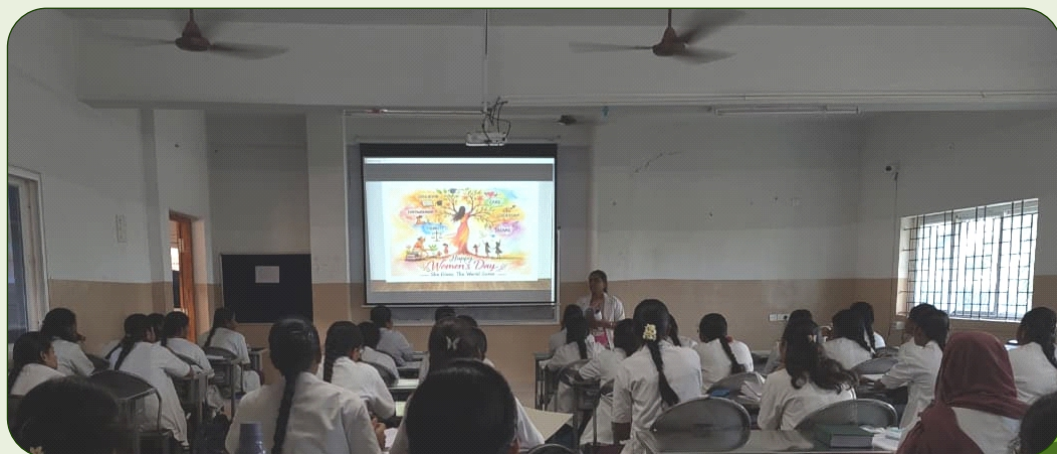


**Continuing Medical Education (CME) Program

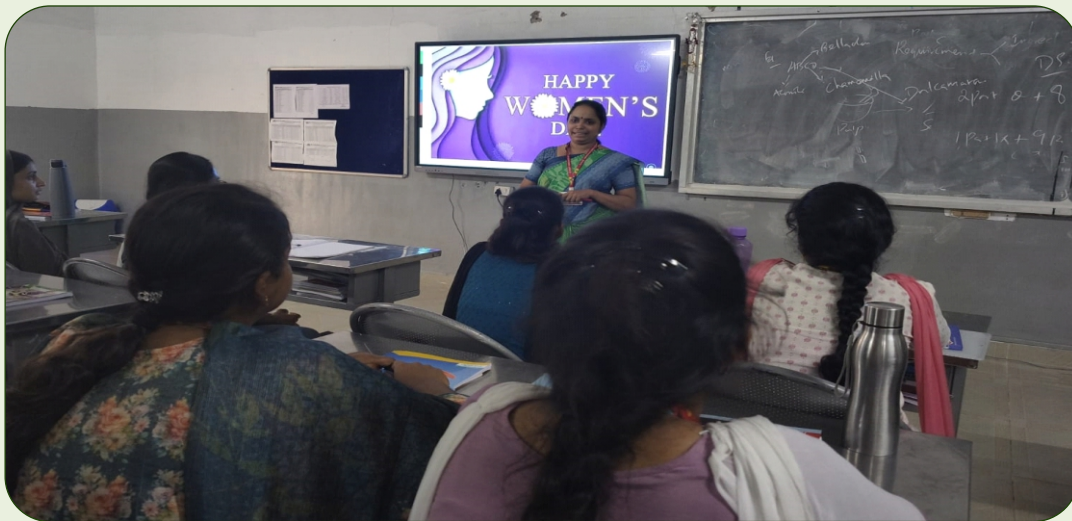

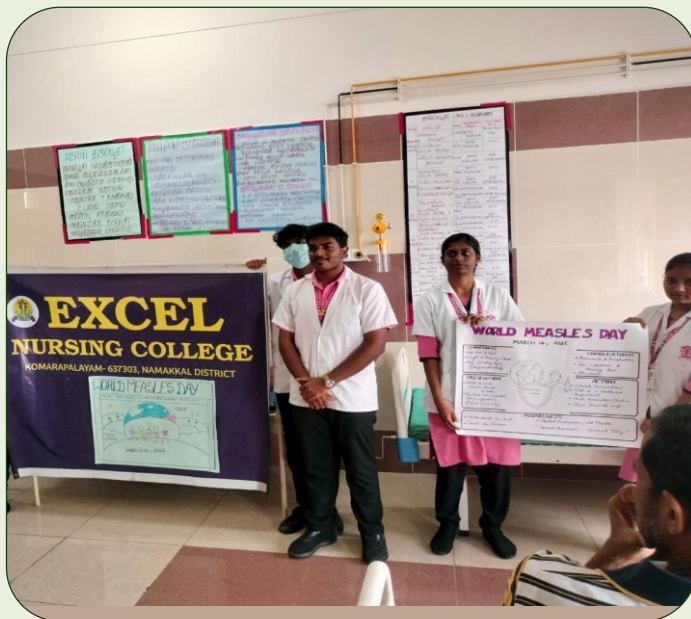


**Report on International Women's Day on
