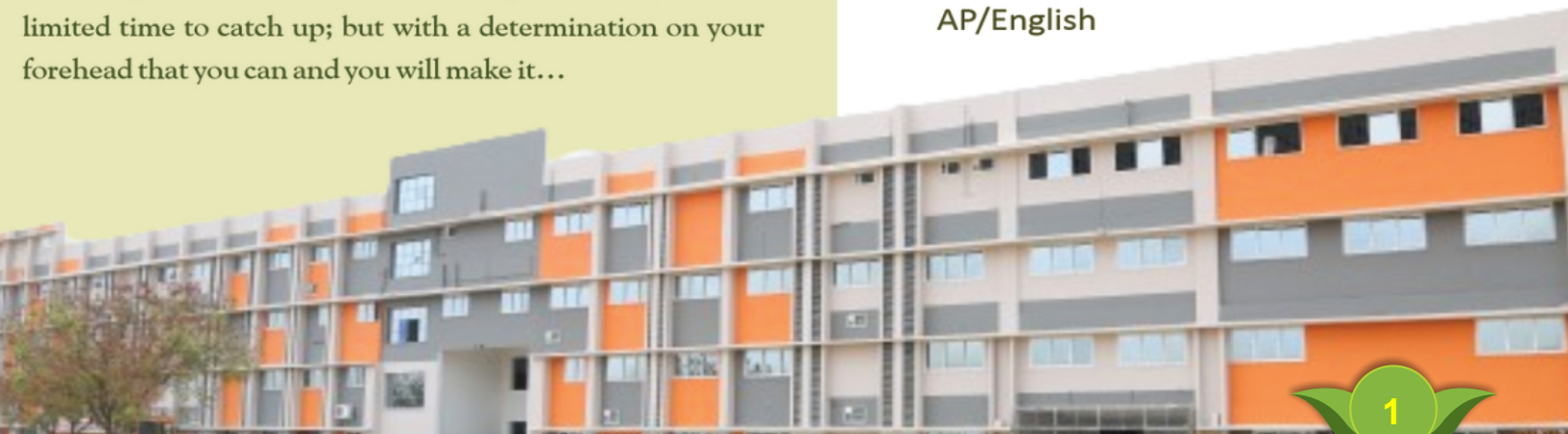

Theme: “Transforming Traditional Wisdom into Tangible Science”

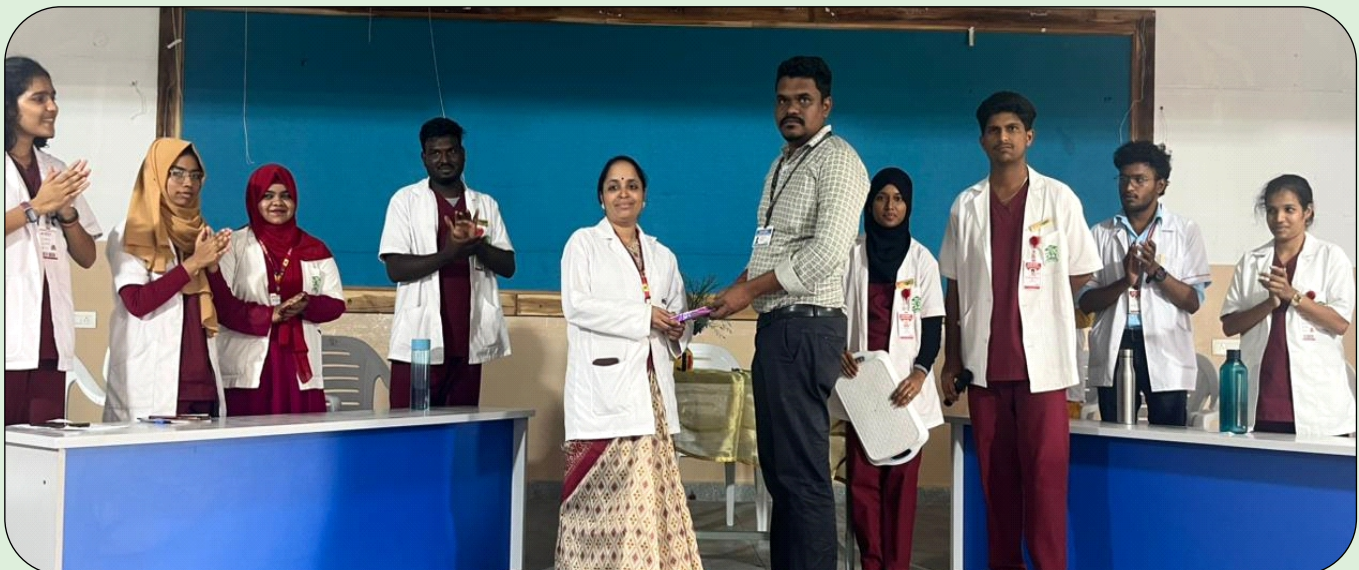
